Writing Goals and Objectives for Play Therapy Treatment Planning

Play therapists often struggle with how to write behavioral treatment goals and objectives. Because writing goals is a necessary part of treatment planning in many settings we will learn ways to construct goals that are compatible with play therapy interventions. We will examine mechanisms that produce sustainable change in the individual's growth and well-being. We will write and evaluate treatment goals so that each session is an intentional step toward the objectives you have set.

Learning Objectives Participants will:

1. Review common methods of writing therapeutic goals and measurable objectives.
2. Examine change mechanisms in play therapy to better identify and link the play therapy intervention with the client's goals and objectives.
3. Explore various models of play therapy to look at goal setting through the theoretical lens.
4. Practice writing goals and objectives using a treatment planning decision-making model compatible with play therapy.
5. Be familiar with play-based activities that help children and their families set therapy goals for themselves.
