Advanced Sand Tray Therapy

Advanced Sand tray delves into the depth therapy of dream work and the Jungian perspectives of the unconscious as depicted in the sand tray. The meaning of the Sand tray is as complex as the person who creates it, as it embodies the body, spirit, emotions and cognitions.

Participants will have the hands-on experience of constructing their own Sandtray world as well as aid others in having insight into their world. Working as a group, participants will dissect a video of a dream depicted in the Sand tray, using metaphor and symbolic interpretation. This training will include lecture, videos, practice exercises as well as working in the sand tray.

Learning Objectives: Participants will:

1. Learn Kalff's 6 Principles of Sandplay and how to implement the principles into Play Therapy.
2. Understand the 4 stages of Sand tray and be able to apply them during a Play Therapy session.
3. Be able to aid your clients in exploring the deeper meaning of their Sand tray during the post-creation phase during the Play Therapy Session.
4. Gain knowledge of Jungian terms and be able to relate them to Sand tray work during a Play Therapy session.
