## Play Therapy with Military Families

Children in Military Families are a unique population for Play Therapists. Due to deployment of parents, moves and the military lifestyle children face frequent loss and restructuring of their family system. Families face new unknown challenges leading to anxiety for both children and parents. Using videos of a military family with a deployed father we will explore the use of differing Play Therapy theories and interventions with individual family members, dyads and the family as a whole.

### Learning Objectives:

1. Describe 5 impacts on children and families by military lifestyle and how to adapt Play Therapy skills for that lifestyle.
2. Identify and respond to three military lifestyle related play themes during play therapy.
3. Confront perceived discipline styles of the military family and how they impact Play Therapy.
4. Practice with 5 directed play therapy techniques that help children and families cope and thrive.
5. Assess video of a military family during Play Therapy sessions spanning a years' time frame.

6. Compile 3 resources that are available for families that will enhance and supplement Play Therapy.
