## Sand Tray 101

This workshop provides a foundational and practical exploration of sandtray therapy within the broader history and evolution of play therapy. Participants will learn the essential materials needed to facilitate sandtray sessions and examine how the therapeutic powers of play manifest uniquely through sand work. The training will also walk attendees through each phase of the six-step Homeyer & Sweeney protocol, offering clarity on structure and clinical intention. Finally, participants will gain an introductory understanding of the neurobiological processes activated during sandtray experiences, enhancing their ability to integrate this powerful, sensory-based modality into their therapeutic work.

### Learning Objectives:

1. Describe the historical development and theoretical foundations of sand tray therapy within the field of play therapy.
2. Identify and differentiate major theoretical models of sand tray therapy and their implications for play therapy practice.
3. Explain basic neurobiological processes and therapeutic mechanisms activated during sand tray therapy sessions.
4. Identify essential materials, spatial considerations, and ethical requirements necessary to conduct sand tray therapy sessions.

5. Demonstrate understanding of the six-step Homeyer and Sweeney sand tray therapy session protocol.
6. Apply sand tray therapy techniques in a developmentally appropriate manner within the scope of play therapy practice.
